


NRB Meets in Nashville



WRGN is here to encourage you with God's word and give you an opportunity to share that word with those around you even when you are not with them. Use it for all it's worth!



Natalie Grant and Danny Gokey, Friday, March 13 at Bethany Wesleyan Church in Cherryville, PA



culture around us. One of the reasons David wrote this book was his concern that Christians are picking and choosing which social issues are important by being passionate about those issues that our culture values (poverty, racism, and sex trafficking) and being passive about social issues that are uncomfortable or controversial in our culture (abortion and same-sex marriage). David's book is a call to abandon comfort and stand strongly yet compassionately for Biblical values in a confused culture, and to let the Gospel shine through our response to social issues.

Spring is right around the corner! Soon we will hear birds singing, flowers will be peeking through the cold dirt, and sitting in the sunshine won't be too far away. Now is the perfect time to sit down and enjoy a new book or DVD from the Good News Library?

Are you looking for God's perspective on the news of the day? Check out *Jesus, Jihad, and Peace* by Michael Youssef as he sheds some light on Bible prophecy and what it says about world events today. In our post-9/11 world, Westerners in general—and Christians in particular—remain targets of Islamic terrorism. Dr. Michael Youssef provides answers that are concise and biblically accurate, explaining how trends within Judaism, Christianity, and Islam fit into prophetic history. You will be filled with hope as you see God displaying His character and purpose through current global events.

As we prepare to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus check out the book, *Last Words of Jesus*, by Stu Epperson Jr. The last words of anyone are a powerful legacy, often reverberating across generations. However, the last words of Jesus soar above all others because of who He was—and is. In this book, experience a fresh encounter with Christ as Stu Epperson recounts the last seven statements uttered by Jesus on the cross, providing unique and thought-provoking insights with additional commentaries from many of Christianity's leading theologians and authors.

Young children will enjoy preparing for Easter with a new VeggieTales book, *A Hoppy Easter*. The Veggies are going on an Easter

egg hunt! With each egg they find, they share a way in which God shows his love. Together they discover that there's much more to Easter than chocolates and eggs. They learn that the greatest way God has shown his love was by sending Jesus, his Son, who gave his life to save us--and that is why we celebrate Easter.

A new historical fiction, *Beyond All Dreams*, written by Elizabeth Camden is part of the Good News Library's collection.
